Hell Hole Landing boat ramp, Rita Island

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise the temporary closure of the Hell Hole Landing boat ramp at Rita Island will be extended to 28 July 2017.

Wet weather and environmental factors have contributed to the extended closure of the boat ramp. The contractor will need to restrict access to ensure the safety of boat ramp users and encourages members of the public to use alternative boat ramp facilities in the Burdekin district at:

- Barramundi (Morris) Creek
- Barratta Creek (Jerona)
- Cromarty Creek
- Ocean Creek
- Groper Creek
- Plantation Creek
- Wallace Creek
