- All nominees and nominators will receive an invitation to the awards ceremony.
- The Mayor of Burdekin Shire Council will present the awards at the Australia Day ceremony to be held on Thursday, 25 January 2024.
- All nominees will receive a certificate of recognition and award recipients will receive a framed certificate.
