Dear Councillor McLaughlin

As you may be aware, I launched the Queensland Superyacht Strategy 2018-2023 (the strategy) on 22 May 2018 at the Australian Superyacht and Marine Export Conference. I also announced that Mr Michael Healy MP, Member for Cairns, will be the Queensland Government's Superyacht Champion and will assist me in the implementation of the strategy.

Superyacht activity in Queensland generates \$940 million into the state's economy and supported 7,210 jobs in 2016. This is expected to grow to \$1.6 billion and nearly 12,500 jobs by 2021.

The Queensland Government's priorities to grow the sector, as outlined in the strategy, include working with the Australian Government and industry to:

- · deliver clear policy settings
- promote infrastructure to facilitate industry growth
- promote Queensland as a global superyacht destination
- support and develop Queensland's superyacht supply chain.

The strategy also aims to attract superyachts to more places along Queensland's 13,000 kilometre coastline to create business and job opportunities in regional Queensland, building on the success of Cairns, the Whitsundays and the Gold Coast.

The Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning (the department) will soon be conducting information sessions in key locations to inform stakeholders of the actions to be implemented over the next five years as outlined in the strategy.

The department will shortly provide further details of the information sessions to council and I seek your assistance with distribution of the details to relevant businesses within your local government area.


