Following the recent changes to the Coalition Government's Ministerial team I am delighted to have been appointed the Minister for Regional Services, Sport, Local Government and Decentralisation. I am writing regarding the Local Government Change Commission (LGCC), the process for submitting local government change proposals to the Minister for Local Government, and council's key contacts during the LGCC process.

The *Local Government Act 2009* (the Act) defines what constitutes a local government change, and outlines the process for submitting change proposals to the LGCC. In summary, a local government change relates to a change of boundaries, divisions, the number of councillors, name, or the local government's classification.

The LGCC is planning on finalising its assessments in advance of the March 2020 local government quadrennial elections, most likely by the end of 2019. As a result, I encourage any change proposals to be made to the Minister as soon as possible to ensure there is sufficient time for the LGCC to assess those proposals, report to the Minister, and make any associated recommendations to the Governor in Council.

Finally, the LGCC has appointed a full-time Secretariat which is the conduit between all stakeholders and the LGCC. Secretariat personnel include Ms Elise Arklay (Secretary) and Ms Katherine Bail (Assistant Secretary), who can be contacted on telephone 1300 881 665 or by email at LGboundaries@ecq.qld.gov.au.
