#### Consultation – annual valuation effective 30 June 2020

The Land Valuation Act 2010 (the Act) requires the Valuer-General to undertake an annual statutory valuation of all rateable land in Queensland except in unusual circumstances or after consideration of:

- a market survey report of the Local Government Area which reviews sales of land since the last valuation and the probable impact of the sales on the value of land since the last annual valuation; and
- the results of consultation with the local government for the area, and appropriate local and industry groups.

Under the Act, annual valuations are required to be issued prior to 31 March in the year the valuation is to take effect.

In line with the requirements of the Act, I seek your local government's opinion on whether a valuation of your local government should be undertaken to be effective on 30 June 2020.

Please provide your response in writing by Friday, 19 July 2019 to the Office of the Valuer-General via the email or postal address details below.

When deciding if an annual valuation will be undertaken in your Local Government Area, I will consider the opinion of your local government, together with the other criteria as specified in this letter, and will advise you in due course.

Dear Cr McLaughlin

Five months on from my appointment as State Recovery Coordinator for the North and North West Queensland Monsoon Trough event of late January and early February this year, and with recovery efforts well in hand, I am stepping down from my role and handing over responsibilities to the Queensland Reconstruction Authority (QRA).

The Monsoon Trough event and the widespread devastation caused by the subsequent floods have had an enormous impact on affected communities such as yours.

It has been my honour as State Recovery Coordinator to be a strong advocate for impacted locals, business owners, farmers, community stakeholders, and council representatives to hear their stories and gain insights into their recovery needs.

It has been a privilege to meet so many amazing Queenslanders and contribute to the long-term recovery of our state.

Your council's assistance was instrumental in my engagement with the community and in identifying your priorities to drive long-term recovery.

This has allowed me to coordinate recovery efforts with state and federal government agencies, including the North Queensland Livestock Industry Recovery Agency, charities and non-government organisations to develop strategies that will ensure those needs were met.

The cooperation between all levels of Government in planning the long term recovery of Queensland communities impacted by the monsoon floods has resulted in a \$242 million joint State-Commonwealth Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements extraordinary assistance Category C and D package.

In addition, more than \$75 million dollars has been approved in Special Disaster Assistance Recovery grants for impacted primary producers, small businesses and not-for-profit organisations and more than \$32.5 million has been distributed in personal hardship assistance, benefitting more than 116,000 people.

Through the development of *North and Far North Queensland Monsoon Trough State Recovery Plan 2019-2021*, it has been my pleasure to work with you on the framework for a locally-led recovery.

I will transition from my role on 28 June 2019 and handover to QRA's Chief Executive Officer Mr Brendan Moon in his role as the State Recovery Policy and Planning Coordinator.

Rest assured they will continue to assist in the rapid and effective recovery of your impacted communities and act as liaison between your council and other state and federal recovery stakeholders.

Support will also continue to be available through QRA Recovery Operations staff, who will continue to work closely with you and the state-level Functional Recovery Groups to coordinate recovery efforts and monitor recovery progress and effectiveness.
