I write in relation to Senator Robert's upcoming motion for 17 February, which seeks to establish a Select Committee On the Use of Commonwealth Grant Money in Queensland Local Government (motion attached).

I write this letter to you as Mayor to express that I do not support, nor share the unfortunate sentiment of this motion.

I have always been, and will continue to be, a strong advocate for regional Councils. The allegation that Councils have enabled corruption or fraudulently misused grant money has been investigated and determined in the negative, by multiple institutions - including the Australian National Audit Office, Queensland Audit Office, Crime and Corruption Commission Queensland and the Queensland Parliament.

RE: ANNUAL VALUATION EFFECTIVE 30 JUNE 2021

Thank you for your response to former Valuer-General Neil Bray's request seeking your opinion on whether or not an annual valuation (effective 30 June 2021) should be undertaken in the Burdekin local government area. You have advised that an annual valuation should be undertaken.

The Land Valuation Act 2010 (the Act) requires that the Valuer-General undertake an annual valuation of all land in a local government area except in unusual circumstances or after consideration of:

- a market survey report for the local government area which reviews sales of land and the probable impact of the sales on the value of land since the last annual valuation, and
- the results of consultation with the local government for the area and appropriate local and industry groups.

After considering the statutory criteria, I have decided that an annual valuation for the Burdekin local government area will be undertaken in 2021. In accordance with the Act, annual valuations are required to be issued by 31 March in the year the valuation is to take effect.
