As we approach the start of the 2021/2022 storm and cyclone season, it is important that communities are prepared for disasters and are ready to respond and able to access assistance to recover if required.

To assist in this, please find attached a copy of the Community Recovery General Information Pack, developed by the Department of Communities, Housing and Digital Economy (the department). It outlines the human and social recovery supports available to people affected by a disaster including useful contacts, general advice, personal hardship assistance grants, housing assistance and support services. I know from personal experience that having access to this information will make your role in recovery efforts easier and will ensure that you will be able to assist members of your community promptly.

I hope this pack isn't needed, but, if it is, please be assured that the department will be ready to support individuals, families, and communities in their journey to recovery. This support takes into account our need to continue COVID safe practices this coming disaster season.

In the event of a disaster, specific information packs will be provided to the relevant councils, which will include Recovery Hub locations and information on personal hardship assistance grants available. In addition to the General Information Pack, this year we have a new suite of tools to support people with disability. The department has partnered with The University of Sydney, and Queenslanders with Disability Network, to develop the Disability Inclusive Disaster Risk Reduction framework and toolkit (http://www.collaborating4inclusion.org/). The toolkit provides information to support people with disability to prepare for and recover from a disaster.
